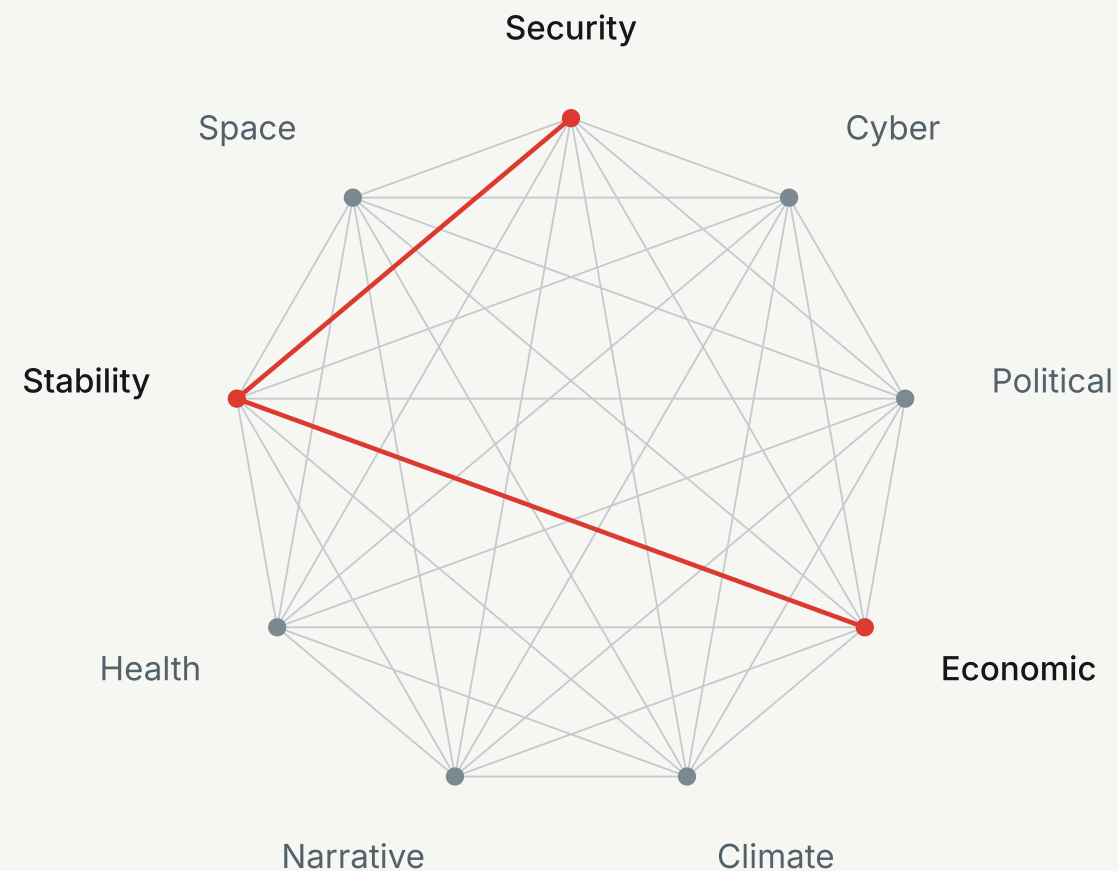
WHERE THIS HAPPENS

Simultaneous cable severance, extended GPS denial across Estonian and Finnish airspace, and a cyber intrusion at a Baltic energy operator force NATO and the EU into a public attribution decision on compressed timelines.
